Completing a score sheet

There are numbered points on the left that relate to the following stages.

- 1) Ensure the name of the archer, round shot, date and bowstyle are noted - the date can be in any format.
- 2) Fill in the arrow scores.
- 3) Complete the dozen totals, hits and golds tallies and enter the round total (On metric and FITA/WA rounds, only 10's count as golds, and any arrow in the inner (faint) gold ring is an X (still scores 10). An X will count towards your gold tally and your X tally.)
- 4) As you continue the round keep adding each dozen total to give a running total in the right hand column.
- 5) At the end of the first distance total up the dozen totals to give a distance total. Total up the number of hits and golds (and X's if shooting an applicable round).
- 6) Check the running total against the distance total. At the end of the first distance these should match.
- 7) For further distances keep adding the dozen totals for a running total.
- 8) At the end of a distance ensure that you have filled out all the hit and gold (and X's if applicable) tallies
- 9) Add up the dozen totals to give a distance total. Total up the hit and gold (and X's if applicable) tallies.
- 10) Once you have finished the round add up all the distance totals to give a round total - this should match the final entry in the running totals column. Add up the hit and gold tallies for all the distances shot beside the round total.
- 11) Check and sign the score sheet - each score sheet must have two signatures the archer and a witness. Only sign the score sheets once they are complete. Even if someone else is scoring for you it is your responsibility to ensure that your scores are complete and correct. Incomplete score sheets will be returned for completion
